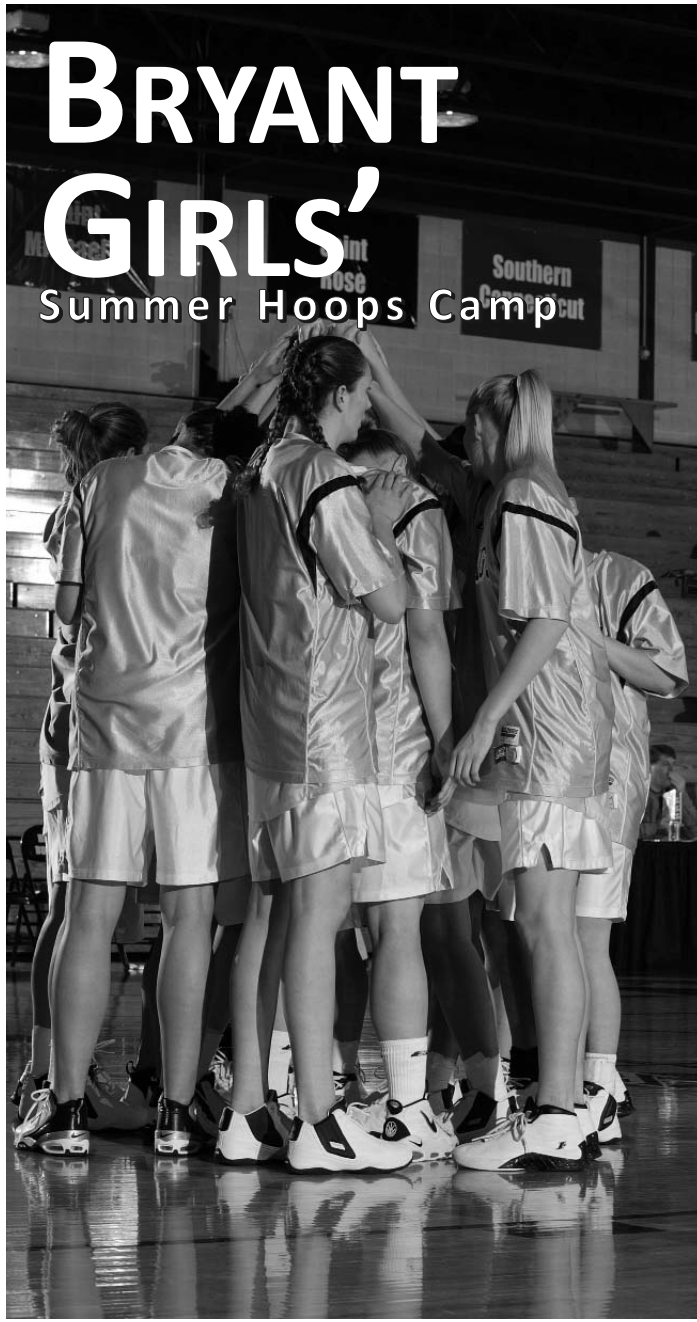

MARY BURKE Head Coach, Bryant University



An integral part of the rich history of amateur basketball in the state of Rhode Island, Mary Burke is in her 19th season as the head coach of the Bryant women's basketball team.

Under the direction of Burke, the Bulldogs have been competitive in the Northeast-10 Conference and on a regional level. The Bryant women made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2004

and 2005, and posted a 19-10 record in the 2006-07 season to reach the Northeast-10 Conference playoffs. In the 2007-08 season the Bulldogs made a run to the Northeast-10 Conference Championship and earned themselves an NCAA playoff berth in their final year of Division II play.

A three-time All-Big East selection at Providence College, Burke was a District I All-American as a senior, helping the Friars to a four-year record of 80-36. She led the 1985-86 Providence team to the Big East Championship game and a bid to the NCAA Tournament, and spearheaded the Friars' run in the NIT the following season.

Burke graduated as the fourth-leading women's scorer (1,672 points) and seventh-leading rebounder (740) in Friar history, also setting a school record with her 43-point outburst against Miami (Ohio) in her final season at Providence.

With her name already prevalent in the Friar recordbooks, Burke was inducted into the Providence College Hall of Fame, Class of 2008, on February 16, 2008. She was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame in 2004.
