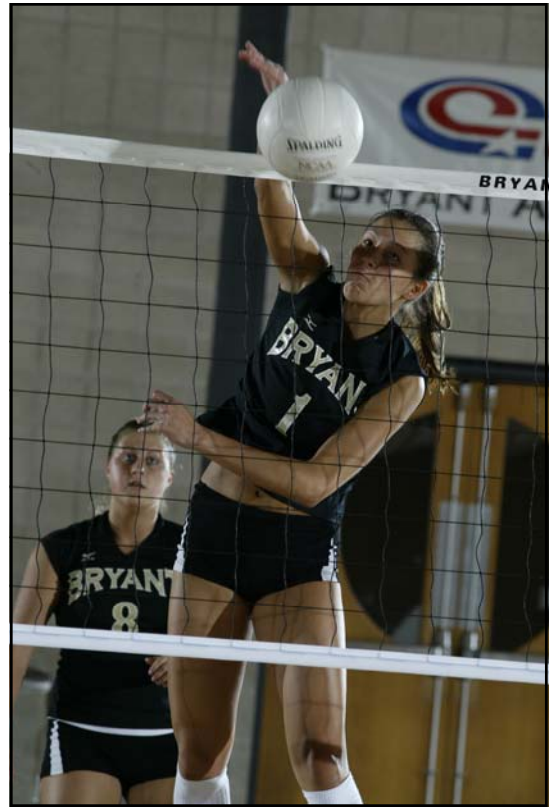

Head volleyball coach **Theresa Garlacy** enters her 16th season at the helm of one of Bryant's most successful athletic programs. The 2008 season was one for both the history and record books. Proving they didn't need time to adjust to a new level of play, - with a 16-19 overall record amid a heavyweight D1 schedule, the Bulldogs proved they could fit right in. Garlacy has a career coaching record of 360-158.

Assistant Directors



Assistant coach **Ted Garlacy** enters his 14th year at Bryant University. Ted plays a key role with all aspects of the Bulldog program, including recruiting, scouting, coordinating practice sessions, match administration, and strength & conditioning. Since Garlacy came to Bryant in 1994, the Bulldogs have won 20 or more matches 10 times and have topped the 30-win plateau on four occasions while making 11 NCAA Division II tournament appearances.



Graduate assistant coach **Lauren Amundson** will complete her second year at Bryant. A former standout at Christian Brothers University in Memphis, Tenn., Amundson came to the program after graduation to continue her education at Bryant's Graduate School. Amundson has also coached for Rhode Island Blast, Memphis Juniors and camps at Western Washington University and Washington Volleyball Academy.

Bryant Volleyball SKILLS CAMP offers local athletes the opportunity to refine critical skills in preparation for their upcoming volleyball seasons.

This camp focuses on individual skills and team strategies. Skills covered range from basic passing and hitting techniques to advanced attacking and defensive schemes, depending on skill level and age. We will emphasize technical development and motivational skills.

Athletes will receive high-level instruction and feedback from current Bulldog athletes, including junior Adrienne Boss (Dracut, MA) and recOrd-setting sophomore Maria Scocca (Melrose, MA).

The camp is offered to girls in 6th–12th grade and promises to be a great experience.

Campers must bring their own court shoes, kneepads and water bottle.
